

1894 - 1904

- 1894 - ASHVE was established in New York City. The first President was Me. E.P. Bates of Syracuse, NY.
- 1894 - Alland Blower Works, Rome, NY.
- 1895 - J.F. Pease Furnace Co. of Syracuse manufactured and installed complete heating systems, including ventilation.
- 1895 - Professor R.C. Carpenter, Cornell U., wrote "Heating and Ventilating Buildings" an elementary treatise.
- 1895 - Hart & Crouse, Utica, NY, manufactured boilers. Went out of business in 1971.
- 1896 - International Heater Co., Utica, NY, manufactured Carton Boilers.
- 1897 - H.J. Brandeles Corp., Utica, NY, installed heating systems.
- 1902 - Willis H. Carrier developed dewpoint control.
- 1902 - Kelsey Heating Co, manufactured warm air furnaces in Syracuse.
- 1903 - J.V. Ibbs Co., Auburn, NY, did heating and sheet metal work. 1948 changed to Mason & Grant Air Handling Inc. Carrier dealers.
- 1904 - American Society of Refrigeration Engineers (ASRE) founded in New York City.
- 1904 - Willis H. Carrier filed patent for "Apparatus for Treating Air"

1905 - 1914

- 1906 - Carrier Psychometric Chart published.
- 1908 - Professor Albert R. Acheson was head of the Department of Applied Science at Syracuse University. Considered the first heating and air conditioning consultant in Syracuse.
- 1911- Willis H. Carrier presents historic paper, "Rational Psychrometric Formulae"
- 1913 - Rosenthal & Chadwick Co. started in Syracuse installing furnaces.
